Good News From Our Projects

It is sometimes hard to convey in a brief newsletter all the wonderful blessings that are happening in our projects, but I thought that I would share a few with you today.

BRAZIL—At the end of April I received news that two sisters from Lars de Meninas had been adopted by a kind Christian woman who lives in a nearby city. These two sisters have lived in the orphanage for 3 1/2 years and were there as a result of abuse and neglect. The girls in the orphanage had a farewell party for them and are happy for the new family for their friends. Although each of them desires to have their own family, they continue to be happy in their loving and nurturing environment and will wait to see what plans God has for them.

BOLIVIA—CERENID is a hostel for boys who have been neglected and abused by their families and are living on the streets. While at CERENID, every attempt is made through Social Services to rehabilitate the family so that the family situation can improve and the children can go back to their original family. In the last quarter, two boys from CERENID were able to reintegrate with



their families. One is a 10 year old boy who has lived at CERENID since he was 6 and the other is a 14 year old boy who has been there for a year and a half. They learned a lot of good values at CERENID and are happy to return to their family. We pray for good things in their lives.

PHILIPPINES—A young boy in the Philippines sent to our office a hand woven bag for his sponsor as a thank-you gift. In his letter he wrote that he had completed his grade 12 education and was graduating. He enthusiastically stated that he had decided to attend the Adventist College and would pursue his degree in theology so that he could become a pastor. He had been so blessed by the sponsorship of his education in the Adventist school, that he could see no other future than to work in God's service as a minister..."I want to serve the Lord and be his instrument to spread his words. With God's help, I'll try my very best to study hard to that someday my parents and you my sponsor who supported me can say that this was all the fruits of my labor...Thank You!!!"
