Wally has not had an easy life, living with schizophrenia for the majority of it, being bullied and ostracized for the way he looked or acted. He had to work very hard all of his life, but he regards hard work as something very good for living a long life.

Wally celebrated his 100th birthday a few days ago. Wally was honoured for the many kind deeds he has done for others in the community. Every Christmas he gave food hampers to people who had helped him. Story after story was shared about how Wally had given of his time to help many people...



One day, when Wally was about 75 years old and living on a small pension, he was helping a lady with her garden and she invited him in for a meal. He noticed a picture on her fridge of a child she sponsored. This inspired him and he went on to sponsor almost 50 children. Most people knew that any money Wally made, he gave to sponsor children.

More importantly, his faith in God has been inspirational to many. Wally loved to talk

about his God. He wrote sermons to send everywhere people would take them, to tell others about "The Most High God" whom he served continually. He longs for the return of Jesus and has done everything he can to tell people that Jesus is coming soon.

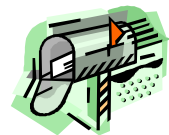
